

Information and instructions for the referee

Student: Ask your academic referee to complete the form. It is the applicants' responsibility to ensure that the reference is submitted in a **sealed envelope** to the appropriate university contact person prior to deadline.

Referee: Complete the form and put it in a sealed envelope marked 'outgoing student reference + student's name' and return to the student.

The above individual is applying for a place to student exchange via one of Malmö University's exchange agreements. A student exchange is an academically and personally challenging programme that expects the students to take advantage of the unique geographic, cultural and academic characteristics of the Host institutions and/ or regions in which they will be living. Students are involved in a variety of challenging cross-cultural situations – both in and out of the classroom – and will be called upon to learn from both experiential and traditional academic methods. To succeed, the application must have a high degree of academic and personal motivation and the ability to interact with people of different social and cultural backgrounds.

When applying for a place at one of Malmö University's Student Exchange Partner Universities, students often need to submit a Letter of Reference. This often requires information showing the students' motivation, adaptability, academic skills and other such qualities. We therefore appreciate any observations that will assist the Partner University in evaluating the applicant, and of special interest are qualities such as competence, independence, assertiveness, quality of performance, confidence, social skills, open-mindedness and integrity. Therefore, we would like to emphasize the value of your appraisal of the applicant's chances for both academic and non-academic success in the exchange period by considering both his/her strong and weak points.
